Steve Moseley manages private equity fund investments and co-investments for the US\$54 billion Alaska Permanent Fund Corporation, a sovereign wealth fund established in 1976 to provide for all current and future generations of Alaskans.

Before joining APFC Moseley founded (and subsequently sold) Rockland Management, a private investment office. Before that he was president of StepStone Group, a California-based manager of private equity assets and, prior to that, co-president of the direct investment division of StepStone's predecessor company, Pacific Corporate Group ("PCG"). During his time at PCG Steve also served as CIO and formed a US\$500 million JV to manage private equity assets in emerging markets.

Earlier in his career, Steve served as a vice president in investment banking at Credit Suisse First Boston ("CSFB") and as a principal in CSFB's private equity investment affiliate, Windward Capital Partners. He received his MBA from Yale University and his BA from Wesleyan University.
