Marshall returned to the firm as a partner in the Mergers and Acquisitions Practice Group in September of 2018 after leaving in February of 2015 to become general counsel of a Dallas-based group of investment companies focused in the hospitality and sports industries.

Some lawyers even try a few different positions before boomeranging to their former firms. In September, for example, M&A lawyer Christina Marshall returned to Haynes Boone as a partner in Dallas after spending a few years as general counsel for a Dallas company and then managing her own small firm.

Marshall said she learned a lot about the client's perspective while working in-house and also about firm management as an owner of her firm. But when Haynes Boone asked her to consider returning, she jumped at the chance.
