

Canada: New CASPA Investment Practices and Funding Policy Guidelines

The Canadian Association of Pension Supervisory Authorities (CASPA) issued new guidelines regarding pension plan prudent investment practices and pension plan funding policies. CASPA is an association of pension regulators that develops harmonized regulatory policies and guidelines to improve pension plan administration.
