

Haynes and Boone CDG Participates in 2018 London Legal Walk

Haynes Boone CDG lawyers and staff took part in the May 21 London Legal Walk, an event that drew thousands of participants to raise funds for legal aid groups.

Partners Emma Russell and Zoë Connor, Associate Emily Fuller and legal secretaries Fiona Bishop and Tracey Ludlow walked in the event, a 10-kilometer walk led by the Lord Chief Justice of England, President of the Supreme Court and more than 100 other top legal officials, judges and members of Parliament.

The Haynes Boone CDG team raised more than £800 for legal assistance work in London and South East England aimed at reducing debt, poverty and homelessness, advancing care for the elderly and disabled, and combatting discrimination and injustice.

A total of 758 teams took part with over 14,000 walkers, made up of law firms, barristers' chambers, banks, legal aid advice centres and many others with the aim of beating last year's fundraising total of £810,000.
