Published annually by Thomson Reuters, *Super Lawyers* is a rating service of outstanding lawyers who have attained a high degree of peer recognition and professional achievement. The selection process includes independent research, peer nominations and peer evaluations of lawyers in more than 70 practice areas. Of those nominated, only 5% of the total lawyers in the jurisdiction can be selected for inclusion.

The *Super Lawyers* directory also rated Cortell, Mesches, and Pezanosky among the Top 100 lawyers in Dallas-Fort Worth. Liberato, Trachtenberg, and Partner [Charles Beckham Jr.](#) were listed among the Top 100 Houston lawyers.
