Super Lawyers recognizes the top lawyers in Washington, D.C., annually via a multiphase selection process involving peer nomination, independent research, and peer evaluation. Only 5 percent of the total lawyers in a state are selected for inclusion in *Super Lawyers*. To be eligible for inclusion in the *Rising Stars* directory, which follows a similar selection process as *Super Lawyers*, a candidate must be 40 or younger or in practice for 10 years or less. No more than 2.5 percent of lawyers in a state are chosen as Rising Stars.
