After a rigorous application and interview process guided by the Keystone Steering Committee, 20 outstanding candidates have been selected for the fellowship.

The highly selective program brings together a collaborative group of diverse Jewish activists, representing the broad array of organizations and affiliations within the Jewish community of New York. Upon completion of this fellowship, the cohorts will receive a graduate certificate from the NYU Wagner School of Public Service.
