A team of Haynes Boone lawyers represented Forest Park Medical Center at Southlake in its sale through Chapter 11 to the Methodist Health System, creating a multi-specialty hospital renamed Methodist Southlake Hospital.

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Texas approved the agreement and sale this week, and Methodist Health System has now assumed ownership.
