The annual awards recognize outstanding achievements across New York's legal industry, with finalists selected through a rigorous editorial and judging process that evaluates the most impactful work and emerging leaders.

The Law Firm of the Year recognition reflects Haynes Boone's continued growth and impact in one of the world's most competitive legal markets.
