Haynes Boone represented SACHEM, Inc., an international chemical manufacturing company based in Austin, Texas, in its restructuring to repay SACHEM’s senior \$120 million credit facility through a series of complex international finance and M&A transactions.

The transactions required coordination with local counsel and personnel around the world by the Haynes Boone global team. The final transaction closed on June 3 after nearly seven months of negotiations and nearly two years of work.
