In specific comments, *The Legal 500 UK* said that Haynes Boone's international arbitration practice has "impressive knowledge and expertise," and that the firm's oil and gas practice is "excellent in any case involving offshore oil and gas, drilling and ship and rig construction" and "has a powerful presence in the contentious and non-contentious space." The firm's London office was created in September 2016 when U.S.-based Haynes Boone merged with London-based Curtis Davis Garrard.
