Haynes Boone has represented Monq Ltd, a London-based startup building the first artificial intelligence platform designed specifically for strategic procurement negotiation.

Founded earlier this year by former Revolut and HSBC executives, Monq raised \$3 million in this pre-seed financing round led by London-based investment firm Outward VC, alongside Cornerstone VC, Octopus Ventures, Lakestar Halo and strategic angels.
