

National Law Journal Names Haynes Boone to 2022 Appellate Hot List

The National Law Journal (NLJ) has named Haynes Boone to its Appellate Hot List. This year's report features an elite group of lawyers and law firms that posted hard-fought wins at the U.S. Supreme Court or in federal circuit courts.

The recognition is part of the *NLJ's* Legal Awards 2022, which recognize the top litigation and appellate work from the past year. All winners will be announced at an awards event on Oct. 20 in Washington, D.C.
