The merger of equals was announced in October and is expected to close in the first quarter of 2023.

Orthofix is a global medical device company with a spine and orthopedics focus, and SeaSpine is a global medical technology company focused on surgical solutions for the treatment of spinal disorders. The merged company will be based in Lewisville, Texas, and will combine complementary portfolios of biologics, innovative spinal hardware, bone growth therapies, specialized orthopedic solutions and a leading surgical navigation system, the companies announced in a release.
