The campaign is the Dallas Bar Association's key annual project to raise funds to support providing pro bono legal aid to low-income Dallas County residents.

The bar association [announced](#) July 24 that Foster will serve with co-chairs Jonathan Childers, a partner at Lynn Pinker Cox & Hurst, LLP, and Cheryl Camin Murray, a Winstead PC shareholder.

"Dallas has the highest number of people living 185 percent below the poverty line of any American city, and this directly affects our residents' ability to access the justice system," Foster said in the DBA announcement. "As lawyers, it is our duty to help those in need gain access to the legal help they need, and that is exactly the mission of the Equal Access to Justice Campaign. I am honored to serve alongside Cheryl and Jonathan to help this worthy cause."

The campaign runs until Jan. 20, 2018.
