The acquisition of Ingenuity Studios further expands Streamland Media's offerings to content creators worldwide, which include customized services from its picture division, Picture Shop; visual effects division, Ghost VFX; sound division, Formosa Group; and marketing division, Picture Head, the company said in a release.

"Streamland Media and Ingenuity Studios are aligned in our creative-driven philosophy and dedication to our extraordinary teams," Streamland Media CEO Bill Romeo said in the release. "We are all committed to facilitating powerful, creative and connected collaboration to advance the vision of storytellers."

Trive Capital and Five Crowns Capital supported the deal.
