Tan talked to Du about her journey as an immigrant to the United States to achieve her career ambitions and how she learned to thrive amidst adversities she faced as a Chinese immigrant to the U.S. This was the first event in FFA's Diversity in Fund Finance Boundary Breakers Speakers series, which is aimed at having open conversations with senior leaders in fund finance to give voice to unique issues and perspectives faced by diverse professionals, and how we can challenge ourselves to think outside established biases and stereotypes.
