Eight Haynes Boone lawyers led by Senior Counsel [Jeff Civins](#), together with other members of the Environmental and Natural Resources Law Section of the State Bar of Texas, updated chapters in the recently released 2020-2021 edition of the Texas Environmental Law treatise published by Thomson Reuters as Volumes 45 and 46 of its Texas Practice Series.

Co-edited by Civins, Baker Botts Partner Aileen Hooks and Lyn Clancy, a Managing Associate General Counsel and Senior Water Policy Advisor for the Lower Colorado River Authority, the book includes in-depth discussions of topics relating to environmental law, as well as an overview of pertinent state agencies, administrative procedures, and enforcement.

Some of the topics explored in the updated treatise include: storage tanks, the Texas Risk Reduction Program, torts, citizen suits and public participation, environmental aspects of business transactions, insurance, and COVID-19 response planning and management.

Under the direction of Civins, the treatise has been updated annually since the first edition was published in 1997.
