

Jennifer Wisinski Honored Among Top U.S. Women Dealmakers

Wisinski recently was part of a Haynes Boone team that represented Stream Energy in the sale of its retail electricity and natural gas business to NRG Energy Inc. for \$300 million plus working capital in an all-cash transaction.

She also worked with a team of lawyers on a deal short-listed this year by both Global M&A Network and D CEO Magazine for M&A Awards. The Haynes Boone team represented KMG Chemicals, Inc., a global specialty chemicals supplier, in its \$1.6 billion cash and stock merger with Cabot Microelectronics Corporation pursuant to which KMG became a wholly-owned subsidiary of Cabot.
